

Judy Antill's work is included in many private and corporate collections in Australia and overseas and in public collections including Parliament House Brisbane, Alcoa, the City of Hamilton Regional Gallery and the WP Holman Clinic, Launceston.

Judy's work has been shown at the National Gallery of Victoria and she has been the recipient of over 30 first prizes.

She has held over 50 solo exhibitions and has exhibited in the Florence Biennale, with Qantas Australia and has had solo exhibitions in London and New York.

In the late nineties Judy started working with Human Rights issues – the galleries she was exhibiting with at the time refrained from showing her narratives so she severed ties with the commercial art world and started running her own art spaces, giving the gallery commission to Human Rights organisations.
